

FEAR NOT, STAND FIRM, AND SEE THE SALVATION OF THE LORD Exodus 14:1-31

Big Idea: *The Lord fights for our deliverance so we can believe in Him (and His leader).*

1. God's Red Sea goal was _____ for His people and _____ for His name.

Moses and Aaron (40 years), Rahab (40 years), Jephthah (300 years), Nehemiah (1,000 years), Stephen, the author of Hebrews and Paul (1,500 years).

1 Corinthians 10:1-2, 6 "For I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea,² and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, ...⁶ *Now these things took place as examples for us, that we might not desire evil as they did.*"

Exodus 14:1-4 "Now the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,² 'Tell the sons of Israel to turn back and camp before Pi-hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea; you shall camp in front of Baalzephon, opposite it, by the sea.³ For Pharaoh will say of the sons of Israel, 'They are wandering aimlessly in the land; the wilderness has shut them in.'⁴ Thus I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and he will chase after them; and *I will be honored through Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD.*' And they did so."

2. At the Red Sea, God _____ for His people while Israel kept _____ .

Exodus 14:13-14 "But Moses said to the people, 'Do not fear! Stand by and see the salvation of the LORD which He will accomplish for you today; for the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you will never see them again forever.'¹⁴ The LORD will fight for you while you keep silent."

Exodus 14:15-16 "Then the LORD said to Moses, 'Why are you crying out to Me? Tell the sons of Israel to go forward.¹⁶ And as for you, *lift up your staff and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it, and the sons of Israel shall go through the midst of the sea on dry land.*'"

3. At the Red Sea, Israel believed in the _____ and believed in _____ .

Exodus 14:31 "And when Israel saw the great power which the LORD had used against the Egyptians, the people feared the LORD, and they believed in the LORD and in His servant Moses."

John 8:34 "That anyone who commits a sin is the slave of sin."

Romans 8:32 "He who did not spare his own son, but delivered Him up for us all, how will he not also with Him freely give us all things?"

Hebrews 13:17 "Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you." (ESV)
