1. We are to put aside the things that
¹ "Therefore, putting aside all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander."
Colossians 3:8-10 "But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth. ⁹ Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its <i>evil</i> practices, ¹⁰ and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him."
James 3:14-15 "But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and <i>so</i> lie against the truth. ¹⁵ This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic."
Ephesians 4:29 "Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear."
