## THE COMING OF THE LORD 2 Peter 3:1-10

Big Idea: Jesus is coming back to judge the world and reward the righteous.

"This is now, beloved, the second letter I am writing to you in which I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder, <sup>2</sup> that you should remember the words spoken beforehand by the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior spoken by your apostles. <sup>3</sup> Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts, <sup>4</sup> and saying, 'Where is the promise of His coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all continues just as it was from the beginning of creation."
Isaiah 66:15-16 "For behold, the Lord will come in fire And His chariots like the whirlwind, To render His anger with fury, And His rebuke with flames of fire. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord will execute judgment by fire And by His sword on all flesh, And those slain by the Lord will be many."

<sup>5</sup> "For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word of God the heavens existed long ago and the earth was formed out of water and by water, <sup>6</sup> through which the world at that time was destroyed, being flooded with water. <sup>7</sup> But by His word the present heavens and earth are being reserved for fire, kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly men."
Psalm 33:6-9 "By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, And by the breath of His mouth all their host. <sup>7</sup> He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deeps in storehouses. <sup>8</sup> Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stancin awe of Him. <sup>9</sup> For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast."
2 Thessalonians 1:7 "And to give relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire."

<sup>8</sup> "But do not let this one fact escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day. <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance."

Psalm 90:4 "For a thousand years in Your sight Are like yesterday when it passes by, Or as a watch in the night."  $\frac{1}{2}$ 

Romans 10:14-15 "How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? <sup>15</sup> How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news of good things!'"
