⁹ “But, beloved, we are convinced of better things concerning you, and things that accompany salvation, though we are speaking in this way.”

1 John 5:13 “These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.”

John 6:47 “Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life.”

Romans 5:1-2 “Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.”

¹⁰ “For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and still ministering to the saints.”

Matthew 22:37-40 “And He said to him, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ ³⁸ This is the great and foremost commandment. ³⁹ The second is like it, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ ⁴⁰ On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.”

James 2:18 “But someone may well say, ‘You have faith and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith by my works.’”

Ephesians 2:10 “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.”

¹¹ “And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end, ¹² so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.”

1 Corinthians 11:1 “Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.”

Galatians 6:9 “Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary.”
